



JOB DESCRIPTION

Full time, aerial and satellite engineer, employed on a temporary contract. We are looking to recruit someone who will fit into our team and will consider both experienced installers and trainees. An interest in audio and visual equipment and practical ability are essential. Work will involve assisting a small team of engineers to carrying out a range of installation work in Cheltenham and the surrounding area. Currently jobs range from domestic aerial installations to commercial multi-point systems.

WHO ARE WE LOOKING FOR?

You need to be enthusiastic and polite with a willingness to learn from others and an ability to work conscientiously within a small team. You should be a good communicator, be able to use hand tools and you will need a head for heights. We are looking for someone with initiative and a positive attitude. Applicants should understand that they will be required to do a physical job which will involve lifting and carrying AV equipment and working at height – as such you need to be physically fit.

WHAT CAN WE OFFER YOU?

A rewarding and varied job for a respected local company. You will receive on-the-job training and follow a monitored in-house training programme. Even those with experience in the trade will be required to learn our way of working. You will have the opportunity to progress within the company and increase your responsibilities as you train; if necessary external training courses will be included at suitable times to gain industry recognised qualifications.

THE WORKING DAY

Work hours are Monday to Friday between 8.00 am and 5.00pm including a lunch break. These times may vary according to the nature and location of jobs; on some occasions you will be expected to start earlier or finish later. Your manager will always attempt to give prior notice where this may be likely but you are expected to be relatively flexible. Likewise where you accumulate hours in excess of the basic hours these will be noted and time given in lieu, overtime will be paid in some cases. The majority of jobs are in Gloucestershire, however, some work is carried out further a field and therefore you may occasionally be expected to stay overnight.

Uniform and work boots will be provided by the company, the employee would also be provided with their own basic hand tools and tool belt. You will be expected to drive a van as your role within the company progresses, so a full driving license is essential.

SALARY

All employees are paid monthly. Your salary will depend on your age and experience. If successful you will be employed for an initial trial period of 3 months, after which, if all parties are happy, a temporary contract of employment will be provided for renewal on a 3 month basis. A detailed contract of employment will be provided if a formal job offer is made.
